When Pat Lurvey and JoAnn Baca did research in the George R.R. Martin archives at Texas A&M's Cushing Library, they found shooting schedules for many episodes. In an effort to provide as complete a picture as possible of shooting locations, this list is compiled from GRRM's records. Production order is listed rather than airing order, in the hopes it will provide a more linear timeline for location usage. Please note that not every Season 1 episode is represented here as, unfortunately, GRRM's files did not contain every episode's shooting schedule.

There are some addresses for which photographs could not be found, nor relevant information provided. To the extent possible, though, we have provided links and photographs of shooting locations.

A list of known Season 2 and Season 3 shooting locations will be part of the 2018 conzine.

You will want to check out the website listed above, as it prominently mentions “Beauty and the Beast” and Vincent! Alas, there is no Ren-Mar Studios sign anymore – the property was purchased in 2010 and re-named RED Studios. But it has a long and storied history. Located at 846 N. Cahuenga Blvd. in Hollywood, it started life in 1915, and was home to a number of studios, including serving as the first DesiLu Studios, where most of the “I Love Lucy” episodes were filmed. A host of beloved TV series were filmed here (besides “Beauty and the Beast”!), including “I Spy,” “The Dick Van Dyke Show,” “Ally McBeal,” “True Blood,” and “The Golden Girls.” Movies were also filmed here, such as “High Noon” and “The Birdcage.” The studio is located in the heart of Hollywood, between Willoughby Avenue and Waring Avenue.

Portions of "Seinfeld," "House," and "24" were filmed there, and movies such as "The Usual Suspects," "Tequila Sunrise," "Gone Baby Gone," and "Blade" (1 & 2), as well as music videos for performers such as Beyonce, Janet Jackson, the Rolling Stones, Bette Midler, and Garth Brooks.

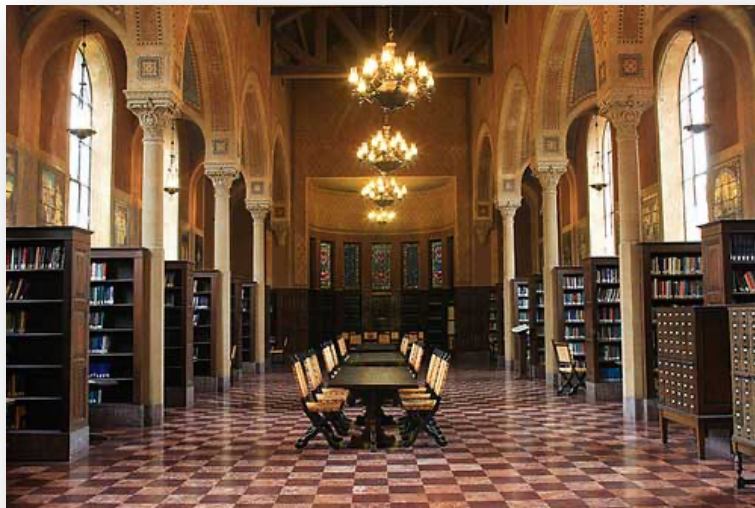
Hall of Justice, First & Spring Streets, LA

The Hall of Justice, a Beaux Arts structure built in 1925, is the oldest surviving government building in the Los Angeles Civic Center. It has played a role in the criminal justice history of the city, once housing such arrestees as Bugsy Siegel, Charles Manson, and Sirhan Sirhan; the autopsies of Marilyn Monroe and Robert Kennedy were conducted there. Devastated in the 1994 Northridge earthquake, it was restored and reopened in 2014.

Although called “Pan Pipes Magical Market” on the shooting schedule, the actual name of this store is Panpipes Magickal Marketplace – “Serving the light and dark since 1971.” It bills itself as a full service occult store serving the entire pagan community. The store has undergone various iterations and changes of ownership since it first opened. According to its website, the store was relocated to 1641 North Cahuenga Avenue, Los Angeles, in February 1988. Therefore, the store interior photo here may not be of the exact location used in shooting this episode. However, it provides an educated guess as to what the store might have looked like before it was “stage set” for filming this episode. The store has been used as a film site for many movies and television shows, including “Unsolved Mysteries,” “Hardball,” and “Rockford Files,” and was involved with movies and television shows such as “Pirates of the Caribbean II” and “CSI Las Vegas.”

The Griffith Park Carousel is privately owned on public park grounds. It is a 1926 Spillman English Carousel with 68 horses in four rows. The carousel has a San Diego connection, as it was originally installed at Mission Beach in San Diego before being purchased in 1937 and moved to Griffith Park in Los Angeles. It is

located within the park at 4730 Crystal Springs Drive. This carousel also has a Disney connection, as it was while sitting on a bench at this carousel, watching his daughters ride, that Walt Disney said he first began to plan the amusement park that became Disneyland. The bench upon which Uncle Walt supposedly sat while conceptualizing Disneyland was donated to, and is now on display at, Disneyland. And fandom has its own connection to the carousel, other than the show; Beauty and the Beast fans helped the current owner replace the horsehair tails for some of the carousel horses through fundraising at several of our conventions.

This is a one-of-a-kind, architecturally remarkable building on the 8500 block of Melrose with parking, just west of La Cienega and east of Robertson. The property is proximate to the Pacific Design Center and Melrose's renowned shopping and eating destinations. Although not on the historic register, this property was

originally a mortuary to the Hollywood elite; Clark Gable lay in state here. The Heritage Bookstore, which was started in 1963, was one of the world's most successful antique book dealers. The property consists of 5,180 square feet on the ground floor and 3,702 square feet on the second floor.

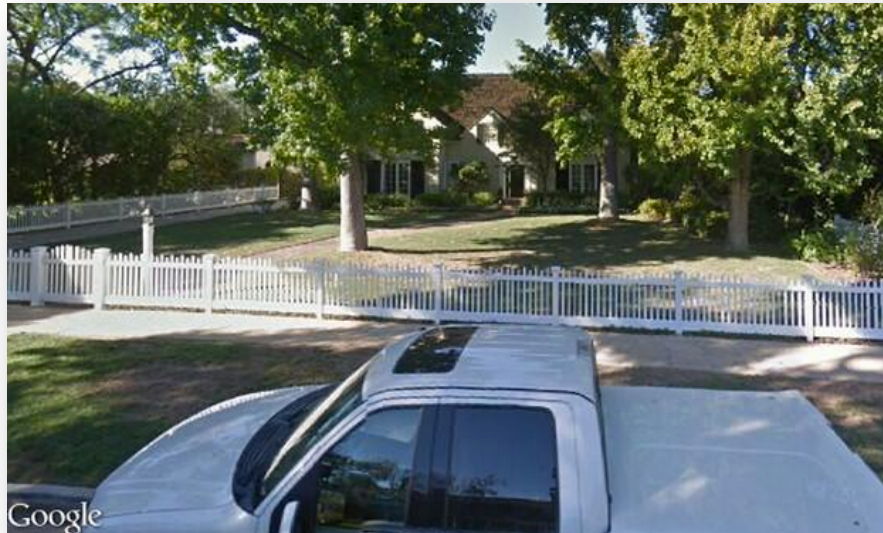
